If we need to go through the often-illegible handwritten payroll ledgers and/or check stubs, the charge [for non-commercial use] will be a minimum of 1 hour at \$15/hour, however, \$45/3 hours is recommended, paid in advance by cash or check. Archive fees help defray the cost of preserving the documents for the public. Your support is appreciated.
